The graduation fee must be paid in **full** by January 15, 2009. Checks will be made out to HERO. Cost for graduation invitations is not included. A group order will be made to maximize the group discount price, however, this is an optional item to purchase.

Non-HERO graduating seniors (do not attend any classes at HERO) will be notified by the Administrator no later than December 18, 2008 if they will be able to participate in the HERO graduation ceremony.

All parents of the graduates must serve on at least one committee: setup (with decorating) or tear-down (includes clean up).
